This flag is signed on the back by many of his buddies in the 167th Signal Photo Co. Also included among the artifacts is a smaller swastika on a round piece of tan cloth; two shirt patches declaring Heslop an "Official U.S. War Photographer," and a 6" Nazi badge emblem belonging to a German military police helmet. Finally there are four different shoulder or sleeve patches as follows: U.S. Second Army shoulder sleeve insigna; the Twelfth U.S. Army Group patch, 1944-1945; the 80th Infantry "Blue Ridge Division," and the WWII U.S. Meritorious Service Unit Badge.
